Christmas 2013 Traffic Management Restrictions: From Fri 6th to Fri 27th December (inclusive)

The pre-Christmas shopping period is a critical time for Christchurch retailers, and it is a CTOC priority to provide safe and efficient access to retail areas and suburban shopping centres wherever practicable during this period.

We are therefore aiming to minimise disruption to people accessing these areas during the two weeks prior to Christmas. Please refer to map. <http://tmpforchch.co.nz/?p=426>

Programme managers, project planners and STMSs: Please ensure that all work causing restrictions on traffic flow, public car-parking, and pedestrian access in the highlighted areas, is completed and temporary traffic management is uplifted from the road wherever practicable by 3:30pm Friday 6th December.

Activities that do not impact on traffic flow, public car-parking, or pedestrian access are not restricted. Normal traffic management may recommence in these areas from 7am Friday 27th December, and there are no unusual restrictions during the New Year period.

In recognition of the intense programme of rebuild works continuing in Christchurch, TMPs that enable works of strategic importance will be considered on an exception basis during this two-week period. For these projects to be considered, the delivery team must:

1. Undertake preparatory work to minimise impact. eg consult with affected retailers, plan mitigation actions (alternative parking, public notifications etc).
2. Present details to CTOC by Friday 8th November of all projects restricting traffic flow proposed for this period. Details must include a summary of the actions undertaken above.
