Roadworks Restrictions Queens Birthday weekend

2 – 4 June 2018

Please be aware that the Christchurch Marathon is proposed to occur on Sunday 3 June 2018 (subject to public submission process), and road space along the route will need to be maximised for the safety of participants and road users.

At the same time over Queens Birthday Weekend (Friday Night to Tuesday Morning) Whiteleigh Avenue rail crossing will be closed for major upgrade works. The upgrade works will require coordination with both the Marathon and any other works in the South West region of the CBD and Addington Areas.

1. Contractors with accepted worksites may be asked to reduce the impact or remove the site for the day – a TMC will contact you should this be required.
2. Works utilising Service Agreements or Generic Plans within the CBD (Four Avenues Area) and the Eastern area highlighted on the map are not permitted on this day unless specific approval has been obtained.
3. Work activities may be permitted on a case-by-case basis. Please contact a TMC to discuss.

Operations on non-highlighted routes are not affected by the above.

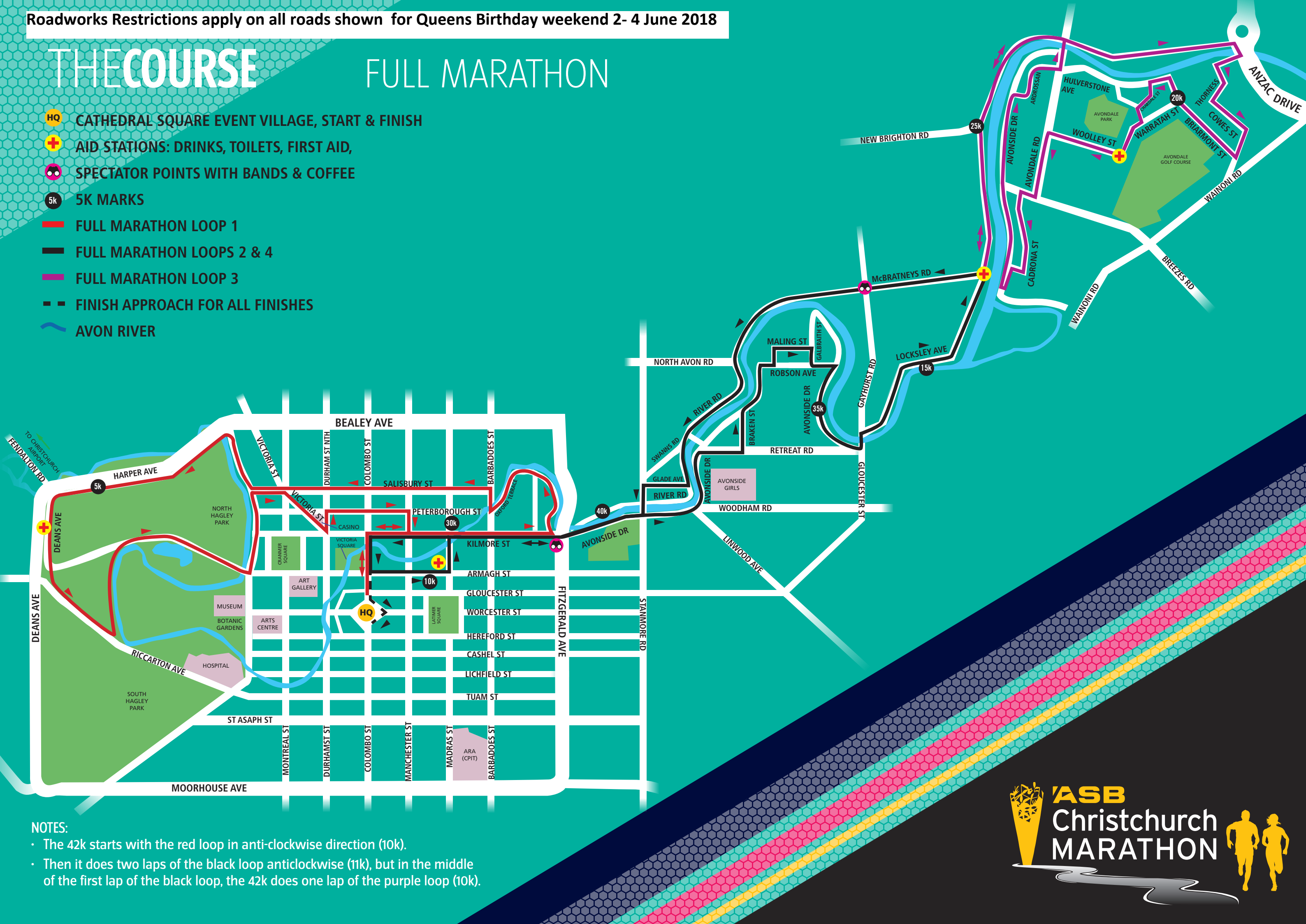

NOTES:

- The 42k starts with the red loop in anti-clockwise direction (10k).
- Then it does two laps of the black loop anticlockwise (11k), but in the middle of the first lap of the black loop, the 42k does one lap of the purple loop (10k).
