Lead up to Christmas temporary worksite restrictions 2018:

Retail areas: 1 – 27 December 2018

Linking strategic routes: 7 – 27 December 2018

The pre-Christmas shopping period is a busy time for shopping centre trading. In the four weeks prior to Christmas, it's critical that shoppers experience safe and efficient access to retail areas, parking spaces, and the strategic routes linking these areas.

To make sure this happens, we will be putting in place temporary worksite restrictions (please refer to the highlighted areas and roads on the attached map). This will help minimise disruption for businesses, shoppers and the community.

The restrictions are:

RETAIL AREAS (shaded yellow on map): 7:00 Sat 1 Dec - 23:59 Thu 27 Dec:

Works affecting traffic capacity, parking and access are <u>not</u> permitted between 7:00
23:59 each day.

TMPs that enable works of strategic importance will be considered on an exception basis during the period 1-27 December. Please contact a TMC to discuss project details by **17:00** Fri 16 November if you wish to request exceptions.

LINKING STRATEGIC ROUTES (corridors shaded orange on map): 15:30 Fri 7 Dec – 23:59 Thu 27 Dec:

- Works affecting traffic capacity (including cycle lanes and traffic movements at intersections) are not permitted between 7:00 23:59 each day.
- No new long-term or continuous worksites are to be established during this period.
- Long-term temporary traffic management at established worksites must be minimised.

POST-CHRISTMAS PERIOD OPPORTUNITY

Wherever practicable, please schedule high-traffic impact works for after the busy Christmas shopping period: 00:00 Fri 28 Dec 2018 – 07:00 Mon 28 Jan 2019. This is a low traffic demand period and, generally, a quieter time for trading. High impact works are likely to be supported by CTOC where no feasible alternative methodology options exist, whereas at other times of the year they may be declined.

TRAFFIC MANAGMENT EQUIPMENT TIDY-UP

We ask you to please put extra focus on collecting abandoned traffic cones and equipment that is not required.

STRATEGIC ROUTE OPERATIONS DURING HOLIDAY PERIOD

Please note that there will high traffic volumes on strategic routes into and out of the city on certain days during December and January, and that some works may not be supportable. Refer to any separate restrictions that NZTA publish around state highway operations. Please consider this during work scheduling on strategic routes.
