Delegation of TMC Authorities to SCIRT STMS Superintendant

Please note that selected TMC authorities have been delegated to the SCIRT STMS Superintendant (Dave Laphorn) for the overall benefit of the TTM system. The authorities enable the SCIRT STMS Superintendant to respond immediately to issues encountered on the network, and to issue suggestions or instructions on behalf of CTOC.

These authorities are effective immediately until further notice:

1. Authority to approach any site and/or Contractor working in the road corridor on behalf of (or in association with) CTOC.
2. Authority to request to be shown the on-site TMP.
3. Authority to suggest improvements and amendments (aligned with LOPs and current best practice).
4. Authority to issue 'Stop Work' instructions, or to invoke actions agreed with a TMC for any Dangerous activities that are not covered by an approved TMP.
5. Authority to invoke corrective actions agreed with a TMC for any activities that Need Improvement, or that facilitate a safer / more efficient customer experience through the site. These objectives are in line with COPTTM Section A3 'Principles'.
6. Ability to view any Accepted TMP on TMPforChch.
7. Authority to perform other tasks on behalf of CTOC as requested from time to time. This may include Incident, Emergency and Civil Defence response.

The SCIRT STMS Superintendant is expected to act fairly between worksites when engaging with Non-SCIRT activities, and is also required to maintain the confidentiality and privacy of any TMP and TTM information that they become party to.

Could you please inform your staff that Dave may interact with their sites in this delegated capacity.
