Good morning all,

You are probably aware that some cordons are still in operation on the Port Hills, with varying degrees of access permitted. Hotspots are still being extinguished and there is a continuing risk of fires flaring up over the next few weeks.

Many cordons have now been lifted and public access is not technically prohibited, however EOC has requested that we carefully consider whether scheduled works should proceed at this time, due to the community remaining stressed and potentially requiring urgent access to lifeline (exit) routes

To reduce community stress while fire control operations continue and to protect available alternative routes, we are issuing a general restriction to non-essential works within the area indicated in the attached maps for the next few weeks (month of March).
